- SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION FOR DEEP, LARGE, INFECTED, BITE, PUNCTURE, HEAVILY BLEEDING OR CRUSH WOUNDS.
- DO NOT USE IF ALLERGIC TO ADHESIVES.
- DO NOT USE IF STERILE PACKAGE IS OPEN OR DAMAGED.
- NOT SUITABLE FOR FRAGILE, DAMAGED, OR BURNED SKIN.

BEFORE APPLYING THE DEVICE: FLUSH THE WOUND, CONTROL THE BLEEDING BY APPLYING PRESSURE, CLEAN THOROUGHLY WITH ALCOHOL SWAB, REMOVING DIRT & DEBRIS, AND DRY AREA THOROUGHLY.

TO APPLY THE DEVICE:



PLACE

PLACE DEVICE EDGES ON EACH SIDE OF THE WOUND, AS CLOSE TO WOUND EDGE AS POSSIBLE.

PLACE AS MANY DEVICES AS NEEDED, 1 MM TO 4 MM APART.

PRESS FIRMLY ONTO SKIN

ADHESIVE IS PRESSURE SENSITIVE.
MASSAGE PADS *FIRMLY* INTO SKIN TO
ENSURE ADHESIVE ACTIVATION.



PULL TILL CLICK

PULL TABS STRAIGHT OUT (NOT UP) UNTIL CLICK IS HEARD AND FELT TO INDICATE LOCKING.



CHECK DEVICE LOCKING PUSH DOWN ON CENTER OF DEVICE TO ENSURE DEVICE IS FULLY LOCKED.

OPEN LOCKED





PATIENT CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

- DO NOT USE PETROLEUM BASED OINTMENTS SUCH AS BACITRACIN OR NEOSPORIN*.
- KEEP WOUND CLEAN AND DRY. CHECK WOUND SITE DAILY.
- IF WOUND IS RED, HOT, OR DRAINING, SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION.
- DO NOT RUN WATER DIRECTLY ON THE DEVICE.
 IF WET, BLOT DRY; NEVER RUB.

REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- ONLY REMOVE WITH PERMISSION OF MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL.
- LIGHT SKIN OIL EASES REMOVAL.
- PEEL EACH ADHESIVE PAD TOWARDS CENTER OF THE CLOSED WOUND.
- DO NOT PULL IN ONE DIRECTION,
 AS THIS PULLS AGAINST THE
 CLOSURE OF THE HEALING
 WOUND ON ONE SIDE.
- THEN PEEL OFF FROM FRONT TO BACK OF THE WOUND, DO NOT PULL.
